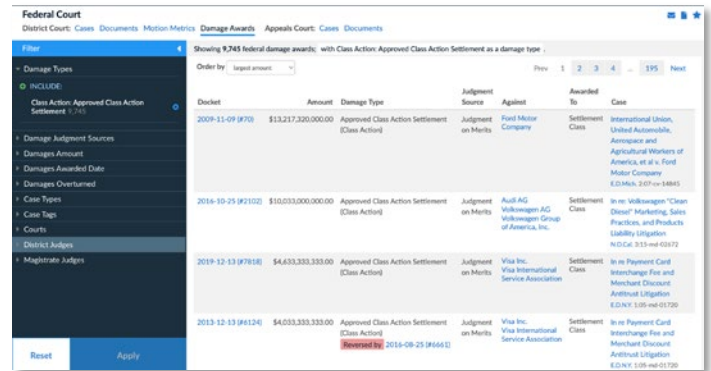
Select Outside Counsel
